A vCard, or .vcf, file is a plain text file:			
<pre>BEGIN:VCARD VERSION:3.0 EMAIL;TYPE=HOME:joeguy@example.com N:Guy;Joe;;; FN:Joe Guy TEL;TYPE=CELL:(555) 555-5554 ORG:Someone Corps TITLE:Some Guy URL;TYPE=WORK:http://example.com END:VCARD</pre>			
To convert it into a QR image, first install qrencode:			
<pre>sudo apt-get install qrencode</pre>			
Next convert the file to a QR code PNG:			
<pre>cat JoeGuy.vcf qrencode -o JoeGuy.png</pre>
