### **Description**

I encountered a problem after creating a jail, I would go to open the <u>Shell</u> icon and the virtual shell screen on he web frontend would immediately close. I tried several times to <u>Delete</u> the jail and re- <u>Create</u> the jail, but that did not fix the problem. I decided open a <u>Shell</u> on the main FreeNAS web frontend, and go to the jail folder that was specified in the <u>Jail -> Configuration</u> and remove the jail cache:

cd /path/to/jails
rm -rf .warden\*

I closed out of the shell and went to re- Create the jail. This caused a new jail template to be downloaded, and this fixed the problem.
