It turns out that the default Kali repository does not include the headers package, and in order to install it the Kali archive repository.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Add the kali-archive apt list: <pre>echo 'deb http://http.kali.org/kali sana main non-free contrib' >> /etc/apt/sources.list.d/kali-i-archive.list echo 'deb-src http://http.kali.org/kali sana main non-free contrib' >> /etc/apt/sources.list.d/kali-i-archive.list</pre> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Update the repository cache and upgrade the system: <pre>apt-get update && apt-get upgrade</pre> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Install the headers package: <pre>apt-get install linux-headers-\$(uname -r)</pre>
