Open <u>Computer Configuration\Windows Settings\Security Settings\Local Policies\Security Options</u>3. Double-click Accounts: Limit local account use of blank passwords to console logon only.4. Click <u>Disabled</u>, and then click <u>OK</u>.5. Close the Group Policy Editor window.
