<b>Description</b>			
<p>Emailing links of currently browsed URLs to various people using the default mail application should be a basic function for a web browser. Unfortunately, Chrome and it's open source counterpart Chromium do not possess this feature; however it is easy to add this basic functionality using a JavaScript bookmarklet.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open <b>Chrome</b> or <b>Chromium</b></li><li>• Right-click the <u>Bookmarks</u> bar and select <b>Add Page</b>.<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the <b>Name</b> text box add:  <code>Send Link</code></li><li>2. In the <b>URL</b> text box add:  <code>javascript:location.href='mailto:?SUBJECT='+document.title+'&amp;BODY='+escape(location.href);</code></li></ol></li><li>• Make sure that the <u>Bookmarks</u> bar folder is selected and click <b>OK</b>.</li></ul>
