### **Description**

I recently installed OpenBSD and went to install a few packages. I'm accustomed to FreeBSD's pkg command, and OpenBSD's pkg\_add isn't as friendly.

• To install the nginx package for the current release and architecture, the long form is:

```
pkg_add http://ftp.openbsd.org/pub/OpenBSD/`uname -r`/packages/`uname -p`/nginx-1.10.1.tgz
```

• To make pkg\_add a little more intuitive, set the PKG\_PATH environment variable:

```
export PKG_PATH=http://ftp.openbsd.org/pub/OpenBSD/`uname -r`/packages/`uname -p`/
```

o Now install the screen package, in short form:

```
pkg_add screen
```

• To make the PKG\_PATH permanent, add it to .profile:

```
echo 'export PKG_PATH=http://ftp.openbsd.org/pub/OpenBSD/`uname -r`/packages/`uname -p`/' >> ~ /.profile
```

• Updating packages using pkg\_add:

```
pkg_add -vui
```
