<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>While performing upgrades on one of my Arch boxes, I found it rather annoying I couldn't exclude a single package (eagle) from the list while upgrading using yaourt, since I like using the --noconfirm option to automate the ugrades. Luckily pacman has the ability to ignore packages an groups during its upgrading process.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Edit the pacman config file:</li></ul> <pre>sudo nano /etc/pacman.conf</pre> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Look for the line beginning with "#IgnorePkg =". Uncomment it and add the name of the packages to ignore:</li></ul> <pre>IgnorePkg    = eagle</pre> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Now update the packages:</li></ul> <pre>PKGEXT=".pkg.tar" yaourt -Syua --noconfirm</pre>
