/etc/issue

• Edit the /etc/issue file:

```
sudo nano /etc/issue
```

o and modify similar to the following:

```
Ubuntu 16.04.3 LTS \n \l
IP: \4
```

Now every time the machine starts, the IPv4 address will display on the pre-login console.
