#### Description

Michele encountered a problem with the coloring scheme which was impeding the work flow of normal transactions. The normal operation to change the color scheme in Quick Books is by going to **Edit -> Preferences -> Desktop View -> Color Scheme**. The problem in this case, was that the field for currently selected items was a color that was difficult to separate from the font color. The cause of this was found to be the Windows Theme overriding the QuickBooks color theme.

#### The Fix

Is as simple as **Right clicking on the Desktop -> Personalize -> Window Color -> Advanced Appearance Settings -> Item -> Selected Items**, from there an adequate color was chosen.
