Open Outlook and go to <u>File -&gt; Options -&gt; Advanced</u> and check <b>Enable troubleshooting logging</b> to enable logging.</li><li>2. Close Outlook and then open it again.</li></ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Open a file manager and go to <u>C:\Users\Bob\AppData\Local\Temp\Outlook Logging</u></li></ul>
