• The is the **incorrect** wget command to download from the AMD website:

```
wget http://www2.ati.com/drivers/firepro/15.201.2401-whql-firepro-retail.exe
```

• The correct way to download from the AMD website:

```
wget --referer=http://support.amd.com http://www2.ati.com/drivers/firepro/15.201.2401-whql-fir
epro-retail.exe
```
