<p>Emailing links of currently browsed URLs to various people using the default mail application should be a basic function for a web browser. Unfortunately, Chrome and it's open source counterpart Chromium do not possess this feature; however it is easy to add this basic functionality using a JavaScript bookmarklet.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open Chrome or Chromium• Right-click the <u>Bookmarks</u> bar and select Add Page.<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In the Name text box add: Send Link2. In the URL text box add: <pre>javascript:location.href='mailto:?SUBJECT='+document.title+'&BODY='+escape(location.href);</pre>• Make sure that the <u>Bookmarks</u> bar folder is selected and click OK.
