| <p>I recently encountered a problem where trying to connect to the WSUS administration console on a Windows Server 2012 R2 machine would result in an error stating that there was a problem connecting to the SQL server.</p> <p>After looking around online, I found that a recent update to WSUS added handling of a new file format to WSUS and required some additional manual configuration after the update.</p> | | | |
