Description

This is a guide for setting up Linux emulation on FreeBSD 11.

Prepare the Environment

- Make sure the system is up to date:

```
pkg update && pkg upgrade
```

Install Linux base

- Load the Linux kernel module:

```
kldload linux
```

- Check that it was loaded:

```
kldstat
```

- Install the CentOS 7 Linux base:

```
pkg install linux-c7
```

- Edit /etc/fstab:

```
vi /etc/fstab
```

- And add the following:

```
linprocfs    /compat/linux/proc    linprocfs    rw    0    0
linsysfs     /compat/linux/sys       linsysfs     rw    0    0
tmpfs        /compat/linux/dev/shm   tmpfs        rw,mode=1777 0    0
```

- Mount the Linux filesystems:

```
mount /compat/linux/proc
mount /compat/linux/sys
mount /compat/linux/dev/shm
```
