I then tried to map the remote share and this time the error came up with:</p> <p>You can't access this shared folder because your organization's security policies block unauthenticated guest access. These policies help protect your PC from unsafe or malicious devices on the network.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">I found that I needed to edit the group policy by running the following command: <pre>gpedit.msc</pre> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Navigate to <u>Computer Configuration\Administrative Templates\Network\Lanman Workstation</u>Then select "Enable insecure guest logons" and set it to Enabled
